


## Nike Battery NY-15 Fort Slocum, NY



The Fort Slocum Nike installation uniquely situated on two islands western Long Island Sound. Due to the compact nature of each island, facility had to be split between the two: the control area was built on David's Island and the launcher area on nearby Hart Island. Historic Fort Slocum served a number of military purposes through the years as both an Army and Air Force installation. Perhaps due to relatively inaccessible nature, Battery NY-15 was closed during July, 1960 after only five years of operation.
