1. Pursuant to the authority resulting from the acceptance of DA Netherlands Case OBG on 27 April 1967, the above individuals, members of the Royal Netherlands Air Force, are authorized and invited to proceed from their present station to the Continental United States for the purpose of participating in the RNLAf NIKE Annual Service Practice firings to be held at Fort Bliss, Texas. Upon completion of this duty, members will return to their proper stations.

a. Warrant officers L. H. Keelen and H. Bouwense and Sergeants J. Oostingh and M. A. Tegelaars, members of the assembly team will arrive El Paso, Texas on 6 December 1967 and return to the Netherlands on/about 16 December 1967.

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b. The remainder of the ASP Group will arrive El Paso 9 December 1967 and return to The Netherlands on/about 16 December 1967.

2. It is understood that the Government of The Netherlands will furnish all travel to and from the United States Army Air Defense School, Fort Bliss, Texas by whatever mode of transportation is deemed necessary and appropriate. Travel in or outside of the United States at the expense of the United States Government is not authorized. All expenses incurred during this tour of duty will be borne by The Netherlands Government.

3. The individual listed herein should inform the Commandant of the U.S. Army Air Defense School, Fort Bliss, forty-eight (48) hours in advance of his expected arrival, by telegram, giving time and date of arrival and mode of transportation in order that proper reception may be accomplished.

4. If the individual listed herein encounters any difficulty in arranging transportation to his destination after arrival in the United States, he will contact the appropriate USPOE, location and telephone number as listed below:

5. The Government of the United States absolves itself from any blame or financial responsibility for injuries received by the individual listed herein while in transit or undergoing training, and any responsibility for any personal or property damage claims resulting from his actions.

6. Prior to departure from present station the individual listed herein will be required to be medically examined and found physically acceptable in accordance with the health provisions of the Immigration Nationality Act (McCarran Act) (Sec 212A, 1-7, PL 414, 82 Cong) and Foreign Quarantine Regulations of Public Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, 42 CFR, Part 71. The individual concerned should be provided with sufficient funds in American dollar instruments to meet all expenses while enroute to and during attendance at the school. Adequate uniforms, as well as, appropriate civilian clothing for off-duty wear, should be taken.

7. The United States will relieve from attendance at schools and request return to the country of origin, any student who violates regulations or who otherwise is a detriment to the class as a whole. The Military Attaché of the country concerned will be informed through the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations, Department of the Army, when such action is contemplated.

8. Request for leave upon completion of training will be submitted direct by the individual to his Military Attaché. Written approval in English from the Military Attaché to the individual will constitute approval for leave.

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9. The mailing address of the individual indicated herein will be in care of the installation to which he is attached.

10. No training other than specified in paragraph 1 above will be conducted on the basis of these orders. If additional training is desired, the individual concerned will submit requests therefor directly to appropriate representatives of his government for forwarding through channels prescribed in paragraphs 50 and 22, AR 551-50.

11. Authority: Military Assistance Sales Case OBG.

12. US security requirements have been complied with. The Netherlands Government has granted the individuals concerned a Security Clearance as indicated above which is at least equivalent to the US clearance required for the training to be undertaken.
